Attention Rough Stock Contestants:

All Saturday Rodeos will have 2 rounds of rough stock except for the October 17th rodeo – there will be NO rough stock that weekend. There is no rough stock on Sundays.

Attention Team Ropers & Steer Wrestlers / Chute Doggers:

For double-rodeo weekends, both rodeo runs will be run on Saturday.

If you are a returning member do not create a new profile, use your existing login.

Membership Opens July 1 and must be filled out online through your profile.

- Print out the membership application and liability form. Fill out forms, have them signed and notarized.
- Upload to the NHSRA Portal and pay the National, State and Region dues online for this year.

3) ONLINE RODEO ENTRY – EQUEST EVENT PORTAL

- Complete online rodeo entry form and make payment on [equestevent.com](https://www.equestevent.com)
- There will be an added fee of \$50 for late entry per rodeo.
- All entry fees, late fees, and any returned checks must be paid before the rodeo starts or you will not be allowed to ride.
- Medical and Vet draw outs will be honored only if notified before the rodeo starts. A vet release must be provided if draw out involves your horse. If your horse is injured during the first rodeo, you must send in a vet release by the following Monday from your vet to receive a refund.
- State Sign up will follow Rodeo #10 - If you qualify for state, you will complete your state packet and PAY ALL FEES which include region long sleeve shirts you order, entries, RV sites, and stalls.

- NEW MEMBERS ONLY - The packet includes photo release form, school form, W9, and social media policy. You will need to upload these forms on your NHSRA portal along with a copy of your birth certificate.
- NEW MEMBER AND RETURNING MEMBERS - You will need to upload Coggins and last year's final report card from the past school year.
- **August 31, 2026 DEADLINE** to upload forms & compete at the first rodeo.

IMPORTANT! Texas Membership Requirements

- Ford Raffle Tickets – must sell 15 tickets
- Bloomer Raffle Tickets – must sell 3 tickets.
- Ad Program Sales - \$50 minimum

6) SPONSORSHIP LETTER

It's never too early to start signing sponsors!

- An event with less than 10 contestants will only be awarded a saddle if a sponsor donates directly to that event for the saddle.
- Rookie of the Year is only awarded a saddle if both boy and girl rookie saddles are sponsored. If only one is sponsored the donation money will be split for a different prize.

7) DRESS CODE

Back numbers are to be worn at all times once distributed at check in.

- CONTESTANTS FULL WESTERN ATTIRE as described in NHSRA rulebook is to be worn during the rodeos anytime you are under the covered arena area. This includes but is not limited to arena, stands, warm up, bucking chutes, and concession stand.
- BACK NUMBERS, COWBOY HATS & SHIRTS TUCKED IN.
